ADDENDUM 1

This addendum forms a part of the Contract Documents and modifies the original Documents dated **September 26, 2022**, as noted below. Acknowledge receipt of this addendum in the space provided on the Official Bid Form. Failure to do so may subject the Bidder to disqualification.

QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS

Question: Where do bidders include pricing for alternates 1, 2, and 3?

Answer: Please see the attached revised bid sheet with a space to enter each alternate and price.

Question: Will the facility be occupied during construction?

Answer: No. Fire staff and equipment will be relocated during construction. Any non-essential equipment remaining in the structure will be protected in place. If remaining equipment and appliances must be removed to facilitate construction, coordinate with the Owner to relocate.

Question: Will exterior antennas and other exterior fixtures be removed and reset to code minimum or will new antennas and fixtures be provided?

Answer: Existing exterior antennas and other exterior fixtures will be removed, protected and stored onsite for Owner inspection. Following inspection, Owner's consultants may recommend upgrading exterior antennas and fixtures. Contractor to coordinate with Owner prior to re-installing existing exterior antennas and other exterior fixtures.

Question: Are there additional specifications for electrical beyond code minimum?

Answer: No, electrical code minimum is suitable.

Question: Are existing roof purlins to remain in place?

Answer: New roof purlins will go in between the existing roof purlins with new X-bracing at mid span throughout.

Question: Are openings 105A, 105B, and 112 new openings?

Answer: Openings 105A, 105B are part of Alternate No. 3, and are new doors built with that restroom remodel if authorized by Owner. Use the standard interior door details. Opening 112 is part of Alternate No. 3 and is a new door built with the new Restroom #12 if authorized by Owner. Use the standard interior door details.
